## BADGE COMPETITION

The “Badge Competition” is available to all shooters, not just residents of Lancashire.

To enter the competition, purchase stickers from Phil Sadler, 8 Pentland Ave. Liverpool L4 5SS. Stickers are numbered and are available in sheets of 12 at 50p per sheet plus a Stamped Addressed Envelope.

Each competition is twenty shots, except Standard Pistol, which is thirty shots. Attach the required number of stickers to the front of the correct targets and have them “Over signed” by a Club Official, before shooting. If, after shooting, the targets qualify for a “Badge”, have them witnessed by a Club Official, complete an application form and send the form to Phil Sadler with the fee by cheque, made payable to “CLSTSA”, Shot cards must be retained for possible checking, until the badge is received.

Badges are colour coded, cost £3.00 for each discipline and show the standard achieved, Marksman, Expert, Master.

Return postage is included for UK shooters. Overseas shooters should include extra funds to cover the postage.

Qualifying scores:- all cards to be shot on the same day EXCEPT Muzzle loading pistol (which can take up too much range time).

Claims for badges must be on targets with consecutively numbered stickers. Each target must be of the score required, or higher.

### **Badges and qualifying scores:-**

Each competition is two consecutive scores of 10 shots (ex 200) except STD Pistol (ex 300, 3 stickers are required). *The colour of each badge is shown in brackets.*

#### **10m Match Air Rifle.** “Air Rifle” (Green)

Master 91. Expert 86. Marksman 81.

Shot on Air 1, 2 or 3/89, or any recognized ISSF tgts. at 10m. 5 or 1 shots per card, as appropriate. Stickers on cards 1 & 3, or 1 & 11, as appropriate. (See note 1.)

#### **20/25 yds .22 Rifle.** “Rifle 20” (Blue).

Master 98. Expert 93. Marksman 85.

Shot on 2010BM/89 at 20 yds or 2510BM/89 at 25 yds.

**Gallery Rifle C/F.** “Gallery Rifle” (Black).

Master 98. Expert 92. Marksman 80.

Shot on PL12 at 20 yards or PL7 at 25m (Inward gauging).

**Lightweight Sporting Rifle.** “Sporting Rifle” (Light Blue).

Master 98. Expert 85. Marksman 70.

Shot at 20 yards on PL14 (Inward gauging).

**10m Match Air Pistol.** “Air Pistol 10” (Green).

Master 93. Expert 82. Marksman 70.

Shot on Air 4/89, or any recognized ISSF targets. at 10m. 5 shots per card. Stickers to be placed on cards 1 & 3. (See note 1.)

**Air Pistol 20 yards.** “Air Pistol 20” (Blue).

Master 93. Expert 82. Marksman 70.

Shot on PL15 at 20 yds.

**Free (Long Arm) Pistol.** “Free Pistol” (Brown).

Master 92. Expert 85. Marksman 70

Shot on PL14 at 20yds or PL7 at 50m (See Note 1.)

**Standard Pistol (Air).** 30 shots “Std Pistol” (Purple)

Master 270. Expert 255. Marksman 240.

Shot on Air 4/89 precision and Air 10 for timed. 5 shots on each target. 2 at 150 secs, 2 at 20 secs and 2 at 10 secs.

Total of half course for badge standards. Stickers to be placed on cards 1, 3 & 5.

**Muzzle Loading Pistol.** “M/L Pistol” (Light Red).

Master 95. Expert 85. Marksman 70.

Shot on PL7 at 25m or PL12 at 20 yds. (MLAGB rules 50% over to count).

**Note 1.**

The competitions for Air Rifle and Air Pistol 10m and Free Pistol at 50m, may be shot on electronic target equipment by placing both stickers on the start of the “till roll” score sheet and having the “till roll” signed by the Range Officer.
