Success for Blackburn R&PC Shooters

The efforts of Blackburn R&PC members in building up one of the best range complexes in the country is showing results.

Blackburn is one of the few Club ranges that can run five different matches simultaneously under the same roof. And, as a result the club members are prospering.

At the National Pistol Championships at Bisley, over the August Bank Holiday, Paul Holdstock of BRPC won Gold in LSR and John Lloyd got a bronze in 25 metre Free Pistol, a sixth in 50 metre Free Pistol and a 7th in the Eley Final for 20 yds air pistol.

Proposed ISSF Rule changes for 2005.

One key change for most clubs is the new Rule (provisionally) No 6.3.15.2.1 "The nearest edge of the bench or stand must be placed 10cm forward of the 10m firing line".

This Rule change will need to be incorporated in the design, or the refurbishment of all "serious" ranges.

Rule 6.3.15.4 will change, increasing min lighting requirement to 1500 lux.

Rule 6.3.16.7 specifies 1500 lux min for 25m indoor ranges - but recommends 2500.

NSRA Gold Medal

NSRA RANGE CONDUCTING OFFICERS

It is an established requirement that clubs which shoot on ranges owned by the military, including RFCA ranges (i.e. Territorial Army), must operate under the supervision of a qualified Range Conducting Officer (RCO), and his presence recorded in the Range Log.

The NSRA has been made aware recently of an incident on a military range when a person signed a Range Log as a qualified RCO when he was not. This resulted in an internal investigation and a subsequent requirement that those proposing to act as RCOs on military ranges are able to "prove" their qualification.

Up to the present time, NSRA RCOs have been issued with an A4 size Certificate and a lapel badge engraved with the holder's name. The certificate is not likely to be carried on the person, and the lapel badge does not positively identify the wearer. The NRA, on the other hand, issues a laminated ID card bearing a photograph, and it has been agreed with the military authorities that NSRA will do the same. Also, in common with the NRA, the NSRA certificate will be renewable after 6 years.

If you use a military range you will need a laminated ID card within the next six months. Others may also apply for an ID card if they wish; they will be issued to all new qualifiers in future and the engraved badge will be purchasable as an option. An application form may be obtained from the Association.
