## NSRA News

**New British Record Score**, 01 June 2010

Shooting in her first outing in a senior British squad at the ISSF World Cup in Fort Benning, Jen McIntosh, 18, set a new British Junior Record Score in the Women's 50m Three Positions Rifle. Her score of 581 (198 prone, 188 standing and 195 kneeling) added three points to the existing junior record and was only one point off the senior record. Jen was one of five shooters on 581 who tied for 6th place, and so had to take part in a five-shot shoot-off. She was finally ranked in 10th place.

Jen's hard work and dedication to her chosen sport is paying dividends since she has now equalled two British records and set this new one so far this year.

## Retirement of Geoff Doe

Geoff Doe, the NSRA's Director of Shooting, retires from full-time employment with the NSRA with effect from the end of March 2010. However he will be continuing to work part-time over the period to September 2010 in conjunction with his successor, Ali Aitken, who is already in post as the NSRA's new Shooting Manager.

Geoff joined the NSRA staff in 1988, having previously been involved with the Association in various capacities as a volunteer. These included 12 years as Joint Hon. Treasurer and periods on the Rifle and Referees Committees. Twice the winner of the British Prone Rifle Championship for the Roberts Trophy, the one major competition to elude him to date is the Bisley Championship Aggregate, having been second on several occasions. However he will now have the opportunity to extend one record he holds as the only person to have held a National Prone Rifle Classification of Class X since its inception; this record currently stands at 40 years.

Geoff competed in the World Championships in 1970 and has a long history in the NSRA-sponsored Internationals, having shot for England in the Home Countries Prone Rifle Match on 41 occasions, and 21 times for the Great Britain Dewar team. On the administrative side of the sport, he has been Secretary of Surrey County and the Worplesdon & District Rifle Club and is the third generation of his family to receive the NSRA's Distinguished Service Medal.
